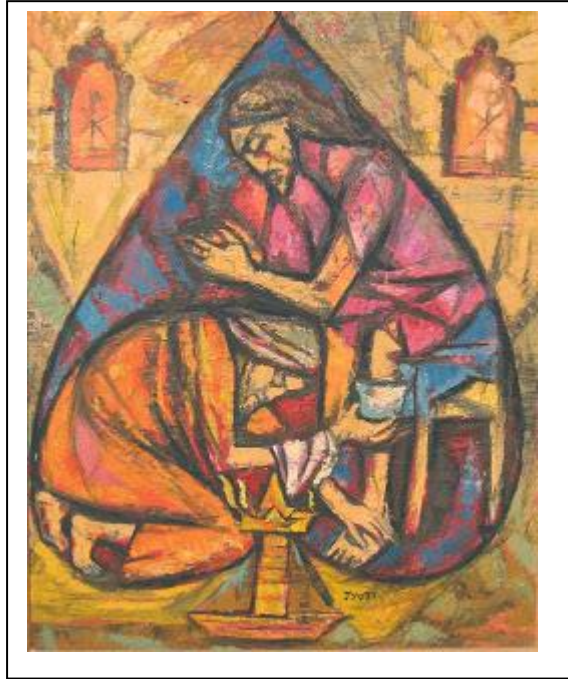


The Gospel of John

Within the New Testament canon the Gospel of John holds a specially important and cherished place. It is both radically simple – emphasising again and again God’s gift of love – yet also became in Christian history the source of profound meditation on the nature of God in Christ. It was St Augustine of Hippo, in the fifth century, who described the book as a place where children could paddle and elephants swim. This study morning on the Gospel of John offered by Clare Amos will seek to acknowledge both the profundity and the simplicity of the Gospel. It will draw attention to its special emphases, and touch upon some of the difficulties, challenges and gifts it offers to Christians today.
